Beginning on March 12, 2016, the Friends of the Millbrook Library will accept book donations **ONLY on Saturdays between 10 a.m. and 1 p.m.** in the Bennett Room on the Library's lower level. Donation receipts will be available. A maximum of **25** volumes can be accepted at one time. Please adhere to the following guidelines concerning the condition and subject matter of books to be donated.

General Condition Guidelines

New: Just like it sounds – brand-new, unused

Used – Like New: intact and pristine condition with no signs of wear

Used – Very Good: well cared for and still in great condition

Great condition means free of mildew, mold and dirt or water or spine damage, missing/cut pages or written notations and underlining.

Book Category Guidelines

We welcome recent fiction and non-fiction, classics, quality paperbacks, and children and young adult books.

Please sort carefully through your books before bringing them to the Library for donation. We cannot accept text books, activity and work books, VHS tapes and audio cassettes, cds, dvds, audiobooks, condensed books, encyclopedias, travel books, magazines or any book not meeting the condition guidelines.

Please **DO NOT** leave books in the Library lobby or deposit in the outside Book Drop on Friendly Lane.

We are grateful for your donated books that meet our guidelines.
